In 2024–25, Proposition 28 funding expanded our instrumental music program for grades 5–8, increasing both reach and quality. Funds supported additional instructors and extended teaching hours, enabling smaller groups, more frequent lessons, and targeted support for all skill levels. Students learn strings, brass, woodwinds, and percussion through in-school and enrichment block instruction, ensuring equitable access. The program builds technical skills, music literacy, and ensemble performance while fostering creativity, discipline, and teamwork. Prop 28 funding allowed for more grade-level ensembles and sectional rehearsals, leading to stronger skills, greater confidence, and higher participation in concerts and community events. Culturally diverse repertoire exposes students to varied musical traditions, promoting inclusivity and broadening perspectives.
